KING'S BOUNTY

Rules of Play

- Players must make a blackjack wager in order to participate in the King's Bounty side bet.
- 2. Casinos set the minimum and maximum bets.
- 3. Players make the King's Bounty side bet by betting in the marked area.
- 4. The dealer follows house procedures for blackjack.
- When each player and the dealer have two starting cards, the dealer settles King's Bounty wagers.

A. Exception: If a player has two Kings of Spades and the dealer has a potential blackjack, the dealer will settle that bet at the end of the round

6. Example of King's Bounty payouts below:

First Two Player Cards*	Pays
2 Kings of Spades + Dealer BJ	1,000 to 1
King of Spades Pair	200 to 1
Suited Kings Pair	50 to 1
Suited Queens, Jacks or 10s Pair	25 to 1
Suited 20	9 to 1
Pair of Kings	6 to 1
Any 20	4 to 1
*Only highest winner paid
