**GAMBLING PROBLEM?

The game is played with a single 52-card deck.

Player makes two ante wagers of equal value, 1st ante bet and 2nd ante bet. The player may also place an optional five-card bonus bet.

Dealer then deals five community cards facedown in such a way that they form a cross.

Each player then receives two cards facedown. Players may examine their own cards.

Player may fold or make a 1st run bet of 1X to 3X the 1st ante bet.

Dealer turns over two outside cards on the horizontal line of the cross.

Player may fold or make a 2nd run bet of 1X to 3X the 2nd ante bet.

Dealer turns over two outside cards on the vertical line of the cross.

Player may fold or make a center bet of 1X to 3X one of the original ante bets.

Dealer then turns over the middle card.

The player then uses their two cards plus the three community cards on the horizontal line of the cross to form a 1st run hand and uses their two cards plus the three community cards on the vertical line of the cross to form a 2nd run hand.

Winning 1st run and 2nd run bets are paid according to pay table listed. The center bet is paid if either the 1st run or 2nd run hand qualify as a win and is paid at the odds of the highest ranking hand.

The two ante bets are paid even money on a pair of Jacks or better and push on pair 6s through 10s.

The five-card bonus is based on the five community cards making best five-card poker hand and paid according to pay table listed.
